SWEET POTATO DISH

3 c. mashed sweet potatoes (more is ok)

1 T vanilla

1 c. white sugar

1 stick butter (or margarine)

Combine above ingredients in a large bowl and mash and put in a 9" x 13" pan.

Topping

1/3 c. flour

1 c. pecans or walnuts (crushed small)

1 cup brown sugar

Mix topping ingredients; spoon over potatoes; dot with butter all over.

Bake At 350° for 45 minutes.
