

From the President's Desk

I have an update on the drainage issue for the newsletter.

I spoke with Judy at Ultra 5. She told me that Manny has the okay to clean out the ditch. I walked the ditch and, in my opinion, the whole ditch does not require dredging to improve water flow. However, where the south drain flows into the ditch, there is heavy plant growth that I believe is slowing water flow, making it take longer for water to drain away. I met with Manny yesterday. We walked the ditch and agreed that he would deal with the growth that is around the south drain. He will ei-ther treat it or dig the growth out by the roots. That should make an improvement. I don't have a time frame when the work will be done. We're still in the dry season. Manny is aware of the approaching rainy season and will get it done before then.

Keep in mind, as growth is removed, it will come back. Vegetation removal will always be an ongoing concern and require attention perhaps twice a year. Also, when heavy rains occur, it is likely we will have water across our roads for a day or so. The drain system will handle average rainfall but during heavy rains, the system gets overwhelmed and needs time to catch up.


