

President's Message

After a conference call with Ultra 5, I would just like to explain the reason for going to a portal system for monthly payments. Ultra 5 was audited by their Insurance company and they were mandated to transition to an electronic payment portal for security reasons. They were able to negotiate the option for residents to be able to mail in a check on a monthly basis as one of the forms of payment. You can now pay 3 different ways - ACH through the portal, credit cards through the portal, or mail in a check every month.

If you decide the mail in process is for you, we still need you to have an account in the portal. This is where you will be able to report deed violations, Ultra 5 can post messages, and in case of emergencies, they are able to email/text mass messages.

If you have signed up to pay in the portal, please email Kim Shores at <u>kashores12@gmail.com</u> and let her know to stop any existing automatic payments that may still be active.

Some residents are still indicating that they have not received anything from Ultra 5 yet regarding this portal. If you have not gotten an email or letter, please reach out to Kim at kashores12@gmail.com and she will get back to you with the portal website and your 4 digit identifier. As you can imagine, she is receiving many contacts with this. Please do not call and email. One email is sufficient, and please allow 2-3 business days for a response.
